COVID-19



- Guests must always bring and wear their own masks –guests not wearing a mask will be refused entry. This includes anyone who claims to have exemption from wearing a mask. No exceptions.
- We provide fully sanitised helmets which are sanitised after each use in a state-of-the-art medical grade sanitizing machine.
- Sanitised helmets we're tested by a medical lab after a 50-minute sanitising cycle and we're proven to kill 100% of viruses and bacteria.
- We provide sanitised and laundered race suits with disposable gloves and balaclavas.
- Driver ages allowed: between 13 and years and up at the Outdoor Circuit and drivers ages 7-years and up at the Indoor Circuit.
- All guests must sanitise their hands at Dubai Kartdrome main entrance sanitiser station before proceeding through to reception.
- Guests must always self-distance. There will be floor stickers and posters with self-distancing measures scattered around the venue 2 meters apart.
- Clients are advised to arrive to the venue in comfortable clothing so that race suits can easily be fitted over the top of clothing
- Clients are to follow the required flow path and must not at any stage try to re-enter reception unless given permission by a member of staff.
- Clients must use the waste bins provided and must not leave any discarded face masks, gloves or food packaging around.

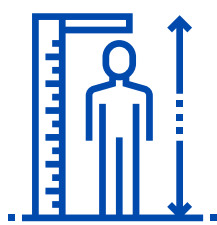

OUTDOOR KARTDROME

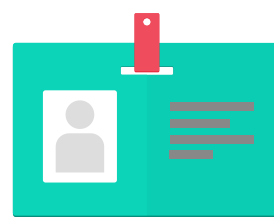
Senior Sodi RX7/RX8 karts
Minimum age: 13-years old



Minimum height of 1m 25cm to drive the Junior Karts



Wear closed shoes
Bring your own
No sandals allowed



Driver's must produce valid ID when registering (Emirates ID, Passport, Driving License).



Race overalls, gloves covering fingers and thumbs

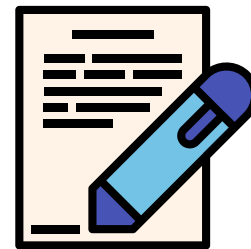
We have helmets, suits, gloves and balaclavas which we provide included in the session fee.

A full-face helmet must be securely fastened and worn during karting sessions

No MotoX, off-road or sky diving or open face helmets permitted. *See additional conditions for more helmet information.*



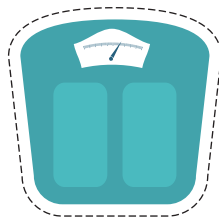

Drivers below the age of 18 years old requires a Parent/Legal Guardian to sign at registration

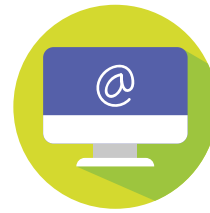


Arrive-and-Drive sessions time 15-minute sessions

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Dubai Kartdrome is here for your enjoyment, however our policies and conditions will be implemented to keep our guests and staff safe at all times.

By taking part in any activity at Dubai Kartdrome, you as a driver, spectator or legal guardian agree to...

- observe all circuit/track rules and regulations and all instructions given by Dubai Autodrome, including our Kartdrome coordinators.
- observe and comply with any advice, instruction, request or decision made by us whether on the grounds of the safety of the driver or any other person or for any other reason at all.
- that Dubai Kartdrome's opinion on all matters regarding safety will be final.
- that any driver acting in a manner which, in our opinion, is dangerous or may interfere with or disrupt the experience, we will at our sole discretion and without further liability to us immediately have the experience terminated without refund.
- the driver must not have consumed any alcohol prior to the experience and we will be entitled at the time for any experience to prevent a driver from driving who, in our opinion, may have consumed alcohol beforehand.
- when required by Dubai Autodrome all drivers, without exception, must wear their own or the provided crash helmet, race suit, gloves and suitable sports shoes. Sandals are not allowed.
- attend the full safety briefing before taking part in the driving experience.

PRICING, CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

- Karting sessions purchased online vs sessions bought onsite will incur different prices. Book online via bookings.dubaiautodrome.com or visit www.dubaiautodrome.com for onsite pricing. Onsite Karting sessions is provided on a first come, first serve basis.
- We reserve the right to cancel an experience due to adverse weather conditions that may affect your safety. We cannot be held liable for any costs incurred in this circumstance. You will be entitled to use an alternative experience session no more than three months after the initial cancelled experience.
- No refunds or rescheduling will be provided for online or over the counter bookings made.
- No refunds will be provided for missed or late online bookings. If the session was missed due to a proven instance out of the control of the customer, a 20% re-booking fee will be implemented for a new date and time.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- AED 11 annual membership fee chargeable to all participants.
- **R-MAX, RX 250 Requirements**
 - At least 10 Arrive and Drive karting session or able to do 1.15.00 lap time at the Outdoor Circuit or have a valid karting race license.
 - Rmax/RX250: Minimum 16-years old
- **2-seater Requirements:**
 - Driver: minimum 18-years
 - Passenger: Must fit safely and securely into the seat
 - Motor City membership card required.
- Bambino Cup drivers must be at least 5 years old to race or practice (ID Required).
- IAME Cadet/Rotax Micro drivers must be at least 8 years old to practice or race, unless the driver has a history of having completed six events (SWS or Dubai Bambino Cup) then 7.5 years old to practice is acceptable (ID Required).
- Driver Height: Minimum height of 1.57m, to drive the Senior Sodi RX7/RX8

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS CONTINUED

For guests who bring their own helmet

Helmets is the most important piece of equipment to help keep you safe. We therefore follow strict international guidelines to ensure the helmet you bring conforms to the minimum safety standards.

All kart owner & rental clients who wish to use their own helmets, must ensure that their Helmets meet ECER 22.05 as a minimum standard before entering the circuit.

Other standards which are accepted:

British Standard BS 6658:1985 and carry the BSI Kitemark (UNECE Regulation 22.05) or a European Economic Area member standard offering at least the same safety and protection as BS 6658:1985, and carry a mark equivalent to the BSI Kitemark or FIA 8860-2018 (with FIA hologram) or FIA 8860-2010 or FIA 8860-2004 NOT VALID AFTER 31.12.2020 FIA 8859-2015 Snell SA 2010 + FIA 8858-2002 NOT VALID AFTER 31.12.2023 + Snell SA 2010 or SAH2010 + FIA 8858-2010 or bearing a CIK certification.
